***Athletic Training Student Scholarship Application***

Dear Athletic Training Student,

Thank you for your interest in the CBATS Athletic Training Student Scholarship. This is the fourth year that we will be awarding scholarships to students in the Coastal Bend. For the past few years, CBATS has been lead by a great group of athletic trainers in the Coastal Bend area, promoting the profession of athletic training and honoring its most valuable asset – the athletic training student.

The recipient of the CBATS Scholarship will be selected by a committee of Licensed Athletic Trainers from coastal bend high schools, therapy clinics, and universities. One graduating athletic training student who plans on majoring in Athletic Training in college will be selected for the Gilbert Tamez Scholarship (\$1,000). A second scholarship, the Allied Health Care Profession Scholarship (\$500) will also be awarded to a graduating athletic training student attending college in the fall majoring in a pre-professional allied health care profession; such as: nursing, pre-physical/occupational therapy, pre-medicine, etc. The two scholarship recipients will be announced at the annual CBATS Student Athletic Training Workshop on Saturday, April 16, 2011 at West Oso High School in Corpus Christi, Texas. *Please note that this year's workshop will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m.*

Please complete the following application in its entirety and mail it to the address provided. Applications are **due on March 1<sup>st</sup> 2011** and we will not consider any applications received after that date as being eligible for either scholarship.

## **CBATS Athletic Training Student Scholarship** Rules & Guidelines

All candidates must provide the following documentation to be considered for the scholarship:

1. Application (completed)
2. Letter of GPA verification and Class Rank (signed by high school registrar)

To be considered eligible for the CBATS Scholarship, applicants must be seniors in high school who are athletic training students with a minimum of 2 years of athletic training student experience. The winner of the two scholarships will be chosen based off of the following criteria as revealed by the application documents:

- Experience as an athletic training student
- Academic successes
- Professional development activities
- Volunteer work

**Applicant:** Please have the athletic trainer who gave this application to you fill out Page 2 of the application form and sign at the bottom of Page 1. Then, please print and **NEATLY** hand-write all of the forms in pen **EXCEPT** for the essay – type the essay in the space provided, print it, and mail the entire, completed application to the following address by **March 1, 2011**:

If selected as one of the two winners of these scholarships, prior to being awarded the scholarship monies, you must provide both of the following documents:

1. Letter of acceptance to state or national accredited collegiate institution.
2. Documentation signed by college registrar declaring a major into Athletic Training or into an allied health profession (athletic training, pre-physical/occupational therapy, pre-medicine, nursing, etc.)

In the case of a recipient not providing required documentation necessary for the award, the runner-up recipient will be given the opportunity to provide necessary documentation to receive the scholarship.

The award check will be made out to the academic institution with the students name on the “for” line. The check will then be given to the recipient to use for academic use.
